Topic: The non-social aspects of autism

Abstract:

Other than social-communication problems, autism individuals are challenged by a myriad of non-social conditions, such as neuropsychiatric and physical comorbidities, which interact with the core autism features to impact on their functional outcome and carer's burden. In this talk, we will explore the possible neurocognitive basis of psychiatric symptoms and how gastrointestinal symptoms may be of clinical significance.

Biography:

Dr. WONG is currently an Assistant Professor (Clinical) at the Department of Psychiatry, CUHK. His research interest is in neurocognitive aspect of psychiatric disorders, in particular, autism spectrum disorder. He is the principal investigator in a prospective study on gut microbiota in autism, in collaboration with the Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Team of Alice Ho Miu Ling Nethersole Hospital and the Department of Medicine & Therapeutics, CUHK. He is a co-investigator of the Work Heart study, a mental health epidemiological study of child and adolescent aged 6-17 in Hong Kong.
