Topic: Youth physical and social suicidal behaviour in Hong Kong – a series of mixed methods studies from a transdisciplinary perspective

Abstract:

In this sharing, I will share some of the youth-related projects, especially on youth suicide, social withdrawal behaviour, and social-emotional learning among children, that I have been working on to examine, disentangle, intervene, and advocate about in the past twenty years.

Biography:

Paul is a clinical psychologist and an Associate Professor in the Department of Social Work and Social Administration, The University of Hong Kong. He has been involving in suicide prevention research and mental health promotion and practice since 2003. His recent research projects include youth social withdrawal behaviour, using animals as part of educational and psychological interventions, youth positive development of local and non-Chinese young people, and family care giving for people with psychological issues. His main research theme aims to promote social inclusion in our society. He is also Fellows of the Hong Kong Psychological Society and the Hong Kong Professional Counselling Association. He is the Programme Director of the Master of Social Science (Counselling). He is the recipients of the 2015 and 2020 Faculty of Social Science's Research Output and Knowledge Exchange Awards, respectively.
